CURLSY HAIR CURLERS

PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Hair curlers

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

- Quantity: 8 or 16 pieces
- Material: PE plastic



USAGE

- The Cursly hair curlers are used to create curly or wavy hair.
- Make sure your hair is slightly damp when you use these curlers.
- Take the curler and unclip it so that the end with the ball pops out of the socket.
- Partition your hair into small sections. Take one hair section, wrap the ends of your hair around the middle spiky part of the curler, and then roll the curler all the way to your scalp.
- Pop the end with the ball back into the socket to prevent your curler from unwinding.
- Section your hair bit by bit and continue rolling your curlers into your hair until all hair is rolled.
- Dry your hair with curlers still secured. Use a blow dryer or leave your hair to air-dry before removing the curlers. This may take several hours or even overnight.
- Gently unclip and remove the curlers. Start at the bottom and work your way to the top of your head.
- Style your hair as desired.

STYLING TIPS

- For best results, apply the curlers on hair that is about 90 % dry.
- Because your hair will be drying under tension, it is helpful to use an extra-moisturizing shampoo and conditioner before curling.
- Comb your hair to make sure it's completely tangle-free before starting.
- If you want very tight curls, use smaller strands and use larger strands to create wavy hair.
- If you blow-dry, allow the curlers to stay in about 15 minutes after you've dried your hair to cool and set the curls.
- Do not pull or tug the curler out of your hair, as it will mess up the curl and may also damage your hair.
- Spray with hairspray to ensure long-lasting curls.
